There are definitely good opportunities. Health care is a growing industry and the need for medical bills and programmers is growing with it. Doctors and other healthcare professionals document the care and treatments they give to patients. Medical turnovers and programmers are specialists within the profession of medical records and health information technician, which is responsible for the organization and processing of these documents. Programmers take information from patients' medical records, convert it to a coded format, and enter it into specialized software based on standardized classification systems. Medical turnovers use coded information to bill insurance companies and patients. Medical turnovers and programmers also work with physicians to solve problems with patients' medical records and ensure accuracy. As a medical bill or programmer, you may find yourself working in a hospital, medical practice, nursing facility, or healthcare provider at home. It's mostly office work and you spend a lot of time using a computer. Some health care providers operate 24 hours a day, so you might work in the evening, at night, or on weekends. You need to be detail-oriented and analytical to understand and interpret the documents that rank and code, according to the American Academy of Professional Coders. People's skills are important and technical skills because they are doctors, people in the sales office and patients who inform about their bills. During training, courses in anatomy, medical terminology and physiology are taken in order to understand the documents in question. Students also study medical ethics, classification and coding systems, and the use of medical billing and coding software. Medical billing and coding training is offered at community colleges, technical schools, and commercial schools. Programs that prepare you to pass a certification exam typically take nine to twelve months. It may take less time if you have a background in health care. An associated degree program takes about two years. Some employers will train you at work, but they usually want you to be certified. Some employers prefer to have an associated degree. Medical billing and coding certification exams are offered by organizations such as the American Academy of Professional Coders and the American Medical Billing Association. The BLS also says billers, programmers and other medical records technicians had a median salary of \$40,350 in 2018. 2018. at the lower end, 10 percent paid the least earned less than \$26,550.
